

Claims Notification Amendment

We agree that Claim Condition 1 is deleted and replaced by:

1. **Notification**

You must give notice in writing to Leeson Claims Services Ireland as soon as reasonably practicable, but no later than fourteen days, of:

- i) any event or occurrence that may give rise to a claim under this **Certificate**;
- ii) receipt of notice of any impending prosecution, inquest or fatal accident enquiry, claim, summons or process;
- iii) **Your** actual knowledge of any accident, dangerous occurrence or incident required to be reported in line with the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Reporting of Accidents and Dangerous Occurrences) Regulations 2016;
- iv) **Your** actual knowledge of any **Bodily Injury** to any person involving a stay in hospital in excess of three business days

Notice shall include the reasons for the anticipation of a claim, with full particulars as to the circumstances, dates and persons involved. All documents related to the above requirements must be forwarded to Leeson Claims Services Ireland as soon as reasonably practicable, but no later than fourteen days after receipt.

You must notify Leeson Claims Services Ireland within two business days of the receipt of any “notice of intention to adjudicate” or of the service by **You** of any “notice of intention to adjudicate” in circumstances which will lead to or are likely to lead to a claim against **You** being dealt with as part of the adjudication;
